To format a paper in APA Style, writers can typically use the default settings and automatic formatting tools of their word-processing program or make only minor adjustments.

General APA Guidelines. Your essay should be typed and double-spaced on standard-sized paper (8.5" x 11"), with 1" margins on all sides. Include a page header (also known as the "running head") at the top of every page. For a professional paper, this includes your paper title and the page number.

General Rules of APA Format Although your instructor may have other specific formatting requirements for you to follow, here are some general guidelines for how to write an APA paper. Use standard-sized paper (8.5 inches by 11 inches). Use a 1-inch margin on all sides.

Such notations are called in-text citations, and APA format dictates that when citing in APA format in the text of your paper, use the author's name followed by the date of publication. For example, if you were to cite Sigmund Freud's book The Interpretation of Dreams, you would use the following format: (Freud, 1900).

An APA abstract is a one paragraph (± 250 words) summary of your paper. It introduces the objective or problem statement of the paper and includes information on the method, research results, and conclusions of your research. In a separate article we explain in-depth how to write an abstract.

Align the text of an APA Style paper to the left margin. Leave the right margin uneven, or "ragged." Do not use full justification for student papers or manuscripts being submitted for publication. Do not insert hyphens (manual breaks) in words at the end of line.

An APA abstract is a summary of your paper in 150-250 words. It describes the research problem, methods, results and conclusions of your research. For published papers, it also includes a list of keywords. Write the abstract after you have finished your paper, and place it on a separate page after the title page.
